

Dear Teachers and Support Staff- Regarding COVID-19 Grants,

Recently, the Michigan Department of Treasury announced COVID-19 grants for kindergarten to 12th grade educational staff (Classroom Teachers & School Support Staff –Full or part-time para-professional, aides, or non-instructional staff, according to the registry of educational personnel) who provided services to students during our 2019-2020 spring closures.

Checks for this grant will come directly from the Department of Treasury to eligible staff members during the week of February 25, 2021. We will be emailing the grant certification form 5734, to eligible teachers and support staff by November 9, 2020 based on the state's reporting to us. It is important to note that there may be employees that are qualified for the grant based on title and FAQ's, but do not meet the eligibility requirements of the grant.

If you do not receive an email by November 9, 2020 notifying you that you are eligible and wish to appeal, please email Lawrence Miller, Lawrence.miller@madisondistrict.org no later than December 4th.
