Congratulations to our Eagles for making the state playoffs for the Michigan High School Esports League!!!!

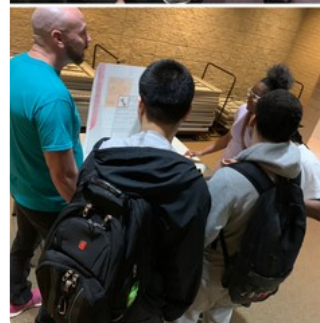
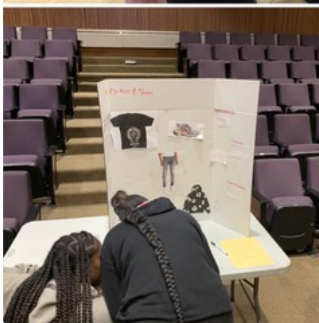
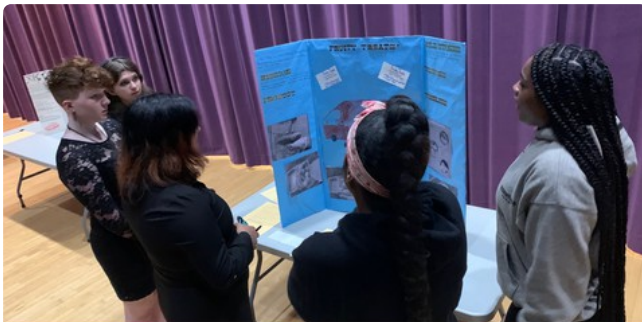
Our Esports and Unified Champions celebrated their season with an end of the year bowling party!

All Michigan high school seniors can be considered for the Michigan Achievement Scholarship, which provides financial assistance for college or career training programs. Depending on the post-secondary path, the scholarship could provide up to \$27,500. 7 out of every 10 students in the state may qualify for the Michigan Achievement Scholarship and students become eligible simply by completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). 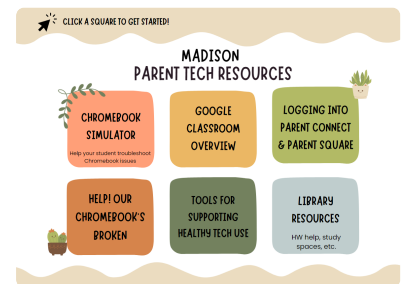
