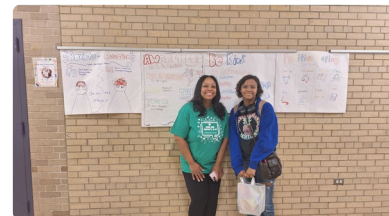
### OUIECE Book Delivery
